

# Queenie Bee

A free pattern by Courtney Kelley

*Inspired by a vintage crocheted afghan, this scarf evokes the warmth of home and family.*



**Yarn:** The Fibre Company Terra, 40% Alpaca, 40% Merino, 20% Silk.

98yards/50grams per skein. 2 Skeins Slate (MC), 2 Skeins Eucalyptus (CC),

**Gauge:** 18 sts = 4" in StSt on 5.5mm needles after blocking.

\*It is imperative you check gauge. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain gauge.

**Needles:** 1 pair 5.5mm (US 9) straight needles.

**Notions:** Tapestry Needle

**Size:** Appx. 7" W x 60" L after blocking

**Skills Necessary:** Knitting, increasing, decreasing.

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## Abbreviations:

K: Knit

P: Purl

K2tog: Knit two sts together

K1f&b: increase by knitting in the front and back of stitch

## Directions:

Using MC cast on 40 sts. Knit one row.

Begin Pattern:

Row 1: K2, (K2tog) 2 times, \*(K1f&b) 4 times, (K2tog) 4 times; repeat from \* to last 6 sts, (K2tog) 2 times, K2.

Row 2: Knit all sts.

Row 3: As row 1.

Row 4: K all sts.

Change to CC and work:

Row 5: K2, (K2tog) 2 times, \*(K1f&b) 4 times, (K2tog) 4 times; repeat from \* to last 6 sts, (k2tog) 2 times, K2.

Row 6: K2, purl to last two sts, K2.

Row 7: As row 5

Row 8: K2, Purl to last two sts, K2.

Repeat rows 1-8 twenty-four times

Repeat rows 1-4 once more .

Knit 1 row.

Bind off.

## Finishing:

Weave in ends with tapestry needle.

Block lightly to measurements.
