



ARRANMORE SCARF

by

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The Fibre Company - Arranmore – 3 (4,5) skeins



YARN

The Fibre Company Arranmore (80% merino, 10% silk, 10% cashmere), 175 yds per 100 gram skeins
3 (4, 5) skeins

NEEDLES

#8 and #9 straight or circular (24") needles

GAUGE

17 stitches and 24 rows is 4" in baby cabled pattern

FINISHED MEASUREMENT

Small – 10" X 70",
medium – 11 1/2" X 75",
Large – 13" X 85"

NOTE

Directions are written for small, (medium and large).
Medium and large are in parenthesis.

TECHNIQUES

Rib Stitch pattern

Note: slip the first stitch as if to knit

Row 1 (right side) – K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, *K2, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1;
repeat across row

Row 2 (wrong side) – *K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P2; repeat across row

Baby cables pattern stitch

Note: slip the first stitch as if to knit

Row 1 - K1, P1, K1, P1, *K4, P1, K1, P1; repeat from * across the row ending with K4, P1, K1, P1, K1.

Row 2 – *K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P2; repeat from * across the row.

Row 3 – K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, * baby cable (K2 together, but leave on needle; then insert right hand needle between the 2 stitches just knitted together, and knit the 1st stitch again, then slip both stitches from needle together), K1, P1, K1, P1, K1; repeat from * across row.

Row 4 – see row 2

DIRECTIONS

With #8 needle cast on 40 (47, 54) stitches.

Starting with Row 1 of rib stitch pattern. Knit in pattern for 6" (7" 8"), ending with row 2. Change to #9 needle and start with row 1 of baby cable stitch pattern. Work in baby cable stitch pattern until scarf measures 64" (68", 77"), ending with row 4. Change to #8 needle and start with row 1 of rib stitch pattern. Work in rib stitch pattern until scarf measures 70" (75", 85"). Bind off in rib stitch pattern, using #9 needle.

Weave in ends.
